

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition caters for Primary school teams. Games are played on Wednesdays. It will begin on Wednesday 17th February and will run through until the 31st March.

The first round will start at 3.45pm and games will start every 1/2 hour thereafter. Games are 30 minutes with a short halftime break.

Teams will be put in the appropriate grades according to age. (We will attempt to even out the grades by having an A, B and C grade if entry numbers permit). The competition will then incorporate several weeks of round robin games leading to a finals day.

Registering for Kiwi Futsal qualifies your team or school to coaching sessions by the Kiwi-Futsal development officer.

Individual player registrations are required— these will be done at the Centre.

THE DRAW

The draw will be available on our website, or forwarded by e-mail to the team contact.

The Edgar Centre will supply referees to all games.

THE COST

A \$25 team registration fee is to be paid by each team prior to the start of the competition.

Teams must pay the registration *before* the 1st game.

Please indicate if a School Invoice is required.

There is a door charge of \$2.00 per player.

There is **no Spectator / Coaches** charge.

THE RULES

1. 5 aside : 1 goalkeeper and 4 outfielders.
Teams can have up to 10 players.
2. Sub's are roll on roll off by nature including the goalie. You can only make a sub when the ball is out of play.
3. The field is marked by the poles and edge of the green carpet. If the ball hits the pole padding this is deemed out. The Goal line is the yellow line.
4. The ball must remain below shoulder height at all times, including keepers throw. An indirect free kick will be awarded from where the ball was kicked. If it was a shot at goal a goal kick will be played.
5. All players must remain on foot, so there are no slide tackles, if this happens a direct free kick will be awarded.

6. Only the keeper is allowed in the semi circle. A goal will not be awarded if a player enters the circle to score. If a defender enters the semi circle, a direct penalty will be awarded from the top of the circle, with only one step allowed. The goalie must stay on their line.

7. If your team kicks the ball over your goal line a corner will be awarded from half way and the defending team must be around the front of their red semi circle. (This does not apply to Pry Junior Grade)

8. If the ball goes out of play you may either throw it in underarm, or place kick the ball in to play.

9. Any deflections off the goalie will be awarded a goal kick.

10. **Indirect Free Kick.** (Free Pass)High ball, accidental hand ball.

11. **Direct Free Kick.** (Free pass or shot at goal) Deliberate hand ball, player obstruction & slide tackle.

12. **Penalty.**(Direct shot at goal) Defender inside semi circle, keeper outside of semi circle. Foot trip/ dangerous tackle.

13. Players must be 2 metres from free kick.
