Our Health & Safety Vision:

"To prevent harm to any person who works at or visits the Edgar Centre"

We believe that:

- No business objective will take priority over health and safety
- Health and safety is everyone's business, and everyone is expected to share in our commitment to avoid
 all accidents and incidents, which may cause personal injury, property damage or loss of any kind.
- Every employee is expected to act safely at all times to ensure their own welfare and that of their fellow employees and others customers within the Edgar Centre.

We will ensure the safety of employees and users of the Edgar Centre by:

- Providing and maintaining a safe working environment
- Providing facilities for health and safety
- Ensuring the facility and equipment is safe
- Ensuring all employees, and other people at (or in the vicinity) of the Edgar Centre are not exposed to unmanaged or uncontrolled hazards
- Developing and implementing emergency and evacuation procedures

To achieve this we will:

- Systematically identify and control all hazards in our workplace. Where there are significant hazards we
 will take all practicable steps to eliminate, isolate and or minimise these hazards to prevent any injury or
 damage.
- Inform all employees of these hazards and the hazard controls.
- Ensure all employees are properly trained and supervised.
- Inform all employees of emergency and evacuation procedures.
- Record all incidents and accidents in our workplace, and take all practicable steps to prevent these
 events from happening.
- Carry out planned self-inspections to monitor health and safety issues.
- Ensure all employees are given reasonable opportunities to participate effectively in ongoing processes for the improvement of health and safety in our workplace.
